# BUILD BETTER



We must rebuild America's infrastructure system. Doing so will create good-paying jobs, increase economic prosperity, and give tens of thousands of hard-working households a shot at the American dream, but it can only happen through bold action.

Our country's infrastructure system is underfunded by \$2.6 trillion<sup>1</sup>, leaving our economy to limp along on a network of critical infrastructure that is overstretched, underfunded, and in dire need of repair. But with a federal investment that matches this funding gap, we can fix it.

Fully funding infrastructure could create 2.3 million jobs by 2024, and inject \$5.7 trillion into the economy<sup>2</sup>.

Every \$1 spent on infrastructure in the Southwest is more than doubled in the local economy<sup>3</sup>, creating good-paying jobs in construction and beyond.

Every \$1 billion of transportation infrastructure investment that comes to the Southwest will support 13,000 jobs a year<sup>4</sup>.

# SWRCC

#### Rebuilding Roads

Wear and tear on our nation's roads has left 43% of our public roadways in poor or mediocre condition. As the backlog of rehabilitation needs grows, motorists are forced to pay over \$1,000 every year in wasted time and fuel.



### Protecting Drinking Water

Our nation's aging drinking water infrastructure system is made up of 2.2 million miles of underground pipes. There's a water main break every two minutes and an estimated 6 billion gallons of clean water lost each day in the U.S., enough to fill over 9,000 swimming pools.



# Securing Our Bridges

There are more than 617,000 bridges across the United states. Currently, 42% of all bridges are at least 50 years old, and 46,154, or 7.5% of the nation's bridges, are considered structurally deficient, meaning they are in "poor" condition.



## Modernizing Our Schools

53% of public school districts report the need to update or replace multiple building systems, including HVAC systems. More than one-third of public schools has portable buildings due to capacity constraints, with 45% of these portable buildings in poor or fair condition.



#### Repowering an Energy Future

Weather remains an increasing threat. Among 638 transmission outage events reported from 2014 to 2018, severe weather was cited as the predominant cause. Additionally, distribution infrastructure struggles with reliability, with 92% of all outages occurring along these segments.
