LOCAL BALLOT MEASURES

YES ON RICHLAND SCHOOL DISTRICT No. 400 PROPOSITION 1

\$357 million bond for replacement of expiring educational programs & operation levy.

YES ON LAKE STEVENS SCHOOL DISTRICT 4 PROPOSITION 1

\$314 million bond to construct, modernize, replace & improve facilities.

YES ON ISSAQUAH SCHOOL DISTRICT 411 BOND MEASURE

\$642.3 million bond measure for school modernization & construction.

YES ON CHENEY SCHOOL DISTRICT 360 PROPOSITION 1

\$72 million to construct & improve schools & acquire land.

YES ON ARLINGTON PUBLIC SCHOOL CAPITAL LEVY RENEWAL BOND MEASURE

Arlington Public Schools Capital Levy Renewal is a 6 year \$81 million Levy that would fund a new Post Middle School, while developing the entire campus.

YES ON AUBURN SCHOOL DISTRICT PROPOSITION 1

\$532.1 million bond measure to construct & improve schools.

YES ON LAKE WASHINGTON SCHOOL DISTRICT (LEVY) BOND MEASURE

\$679.9 million bond to modernize construct & improve Schools.

YES ON PORT ANGELES SCHOOL DISTRICT PROPOSITION 2

\$140 million proposition to replace expiring Levy & pay for new construction & building renovations to improve safety & accessibility of schools & facilities.

YES ON SEATTLE SCHOOL DISTRICT BOND MEASURE

Approval of a 6-year capital levy to fund the Building Excellence (BEX) VI Capital Levy program. It would be a \$1.8 Billion over 6-year term. Levy is primarily focused on new construction and major renovations.
